## Quick Look Procedure Resource for CRITICAL CARE staff Supervision and Delegation

Registered nurses (Critical Care Nurses) are responsible for managing the nursing care, delegation and supervision of care provided by others in the team.

## Skills /Roles

Critical Care Nurse -Work to their skills and knowledge parameters Including but not limited to:

- Leadership and Supervision of team, escalating problems accordingly
- Haemodynamic Parameters for each patient when they need alerting
- Ventilation observation parameters
- Titration and changes over of inotropes /vasopressors

All redeployed staff entering into the Critical Care should identify their knowledge and skills and be under supervision of a critical care nurse

## Registered Nurse (Category 'A')

- Ventilation
  - Care of the ETT/Tracheostomy, patient position changes, securing device monitoring and application
  - In-line suctioning
  - Ventilator observations
  - Respond to ventilator alarms and troubleshoots escalates /report to supervising nurse
- Invasive Lines
  - Assessment of invasive lines/drains and performs dressing changes
  - Manage / Maintain lines change of transducer sets / pressure bag
  - o Blood sampling from invasive lines i.e. ABG's
  - Report results to supervising/senior nurse
- Drugs
  - o Administer and manage IV infusions -antibiotics /IV fluids etc
  - Assist critical care nurse with inotropes /vasopressors
  - Management of controlled drugs

## Clinical Care Worker (Category 'B')

- Offer comfort and support to patient
- Record haemodynamic observations -report to supervising/senior nurse
- Record urine output emptying drainage bags escalate as instructed
- Patient care: provide hygiene needs e.g. eye/mouth care, assist with positional changes – report any problem
